Program Details

The Boone Memorial Hospital Volunteen Program was established in 2019. BMH Volunteens are dedicated to leadership and service and volunteer their time and talents at Boone Memorial Hospital.

REQUIREMENTS & TIME COMMITMENT:

- \Rightarrow Must be between the age of 15-20
- ⇒ Must be willing to give at least 6 hours of service at BMH per week for at least 30 total weeks per year

 ⇒ Should hold a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- ⇒ Only students who are currently attending or graduated from a *Boone County* High School are eligible
- ⇒ Volunteen hours will take place week days after school and/or weekends-No volunteering after 9pm or on Sundays
- ⇒ Volunteens should provide own transportation
- ⇒ Volunteens will be required to complete hospital HIPAA Training: The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996 was passed by congress in an effort to aid people in keeping health insurance as well as protecting the confidentiality and security of health information
- Volunteens will be certified in CPR/ First Aid
- ⇒ Volunteens must attend a hospital orientation/team building session



Note: HIPAA Training and CPR/First Aid Certification will be provided by BMH at no charge to the student Volunteen
